⚡ Kenny Eicholtz Drums and Lead Vocals

Kenny has an accomplished background as a musician, having played in several local bands during his high school years, including but not limited to, the legendary bands Pendulum, Stained Class, and Hit and Run. His passion and commitment to music led him to join NoXit in 2008, and since then, he has significantly contributed to the band's success.

Kenny's enthusiasm for the band's live performances is well-known, and his driving force behind the lights and effects creates high-energy shows that always leave the crowd in awe. Notably, Kenny is also a devoted Kiss fan, and this is a major influence on his creative approach to live performances.

Steve played in several local bands including the well-known area band Pendulum, before locating to the west coast in the early 80's. Steve was the lead guitarist for Panzer, one of the premier San Jose CA Bay Area rock bands. Their released single received frequent airplay on both local radio stations KOME and KSJO. After relocating back to the Frederick area, Steve played in several local cover rock bands, and the blues band Black Magic and Last Dog Standing, which was a semi-finalist for the International Blues Challenge in Memphis in 2006, as well as winners of the Best Blues Band, and Blues Guitarist categories, 2 years in a row from the Frederick Blues Society. Steve was also the winner of Guitar Center's "King of the Blues" central east coast region guitar competition in 2006.

Steve joined NoXit in 2017 and has enjoyed every minute since. Steve currently teaches at Make 'n Music in Frederick. Steve has appeared on several studio recordings and CD releases. He also runs his own home studio and is working on several solo projects. Steve has a diverse background in music styles and cites his major influences as Michel Schenker of UFO, Stevie Ray Vaughan, Gary Moore, Joe Satriani and Edward Van Halen.

Joe has a remarkable background in classical piano, having started playing at just four years of age. Interestingly, his older brother was inspired by watching the band Pendulum during his early teenage years to pick up the guitar and explore his own passion for music. Pendulum eventually morphed into the successful band NoXit, where Joe's exceptional keyboard skills became recognized and he was recruited as a keyboardist. As the sole remaining original member of NoXit, Joe's contributions to the band's signature sound are invaluable.

⚡ Steph Doyle Bass and Vocals

Steph is the newest addition to NoXiT. He is known for his open, and at times, aggressive bass style and is not afraid of displaying musical passion and contagious energy while performing on stage. Steph is also a very talented graphic artist. He is the force behind our t-shirts, website, and all our cool graphics.

Steph got his start playing bass during his high school years in Northern Utah. He played in several bands throughout his teen years during the late 70s into the early 80s. His associated bands ranged from classic 70s rock to early 80s metal. He eventually joined a professional country band in 1981 working as bassist for Jimmy Love and the Law n' Order Band, touring from northern Texas to Arizona.

While living in San Antonio, Texas, he worked as bassist for a modern country cover band, the Boot Hill Boys. This band was comprised of all active-duty Air Force members and they toured central Texas from 1990-1996.

Once he settled into Frederick, Maryland, he joined a number of bands along the way, to include Huckleberry Hooch, The Tommy Rockers, and Unrefined. Steph currently dedicates his talents to NoXiT and studies bass and music theory under Dave DeMarco, from Crack the Sky.



⚡ Mark Ramsburg Light and Sound Technician

Every great act has someone that works tirelessly behind the scenes to make them look great. Mark is that person. Mark started playing drums at 7 years old, he played in Marching, Jazz and Concert bands through High School and in several local cover bands after High School. In fact, Mark and Steve played together in one of those early bands right after high school.

Around 1978 Mark started working on the Production side, and has been doing Lighting for over 40 years now. More recently the last 10 years he has been working on the Sound side of Production. Mark has worked with several bands over the years, and has been exclusively with NoXiT for the last 15 years. He occasionally helps out with other bands and production companies if needed. He also volunteers his time as a Sound Tech at Crossroads Church in State Line, Pa. Mark typically shows up in the morning of a gig to set up the light and effects show, and the band's sound system for that evening. He has been an integral part of the band's conversion from analog to digital, programming the light show and running lights, special effects and sound.
